Re-Opening Directives

Effective Wednesday, May 26th, St. Joseph's Credit Union will begin a gradual reopening of services. To proceed with the re-opening of the doors of St. Joseph's Credit Union, we have put in place the following measures which MUST be adhered to. We are expecting everyone's cooperation as we navigate through these ever-changing times.

- No one can enter the premises if they have been out of the province or country within the last 14 days if they have been in contact with anyone who may have travelled from another province or if they are feeling ill.
- Effective May 26th, our doors will be open from 9:00am-2:00pm, Monday through Friday. Staff will continue to remain on site until 4:00 pm each day, to assist our members over the phone.
- Everyone entering the building must disinfect their hands with hand sanitizer provided within the branch. Masks are mandatory.
- Only 3 Members at a time will be permitted in branch. Only 1 Member is permitted to wait in the porch and that member must wait outside if there is someone needing to use the ATM.
- We are strongly encouraging that members limit their visits to the Credit Union to one day per week and less frequent if possible. Maintaining low traffic will help us to control the spread of COVID 19.
- At this time, public washrooms will remain closed.
- Members are encouraged to continue calling in to the branch and/or use online banking and the ATM and help minimize the amount of traffic in the branch.
- Enhanced cleaning and disinfecting will take place regularly.
